

Measured Practice Bay Rules

(There are no exceptions to these rules without prior permission of the Prescott Action Shooters Range Master)

- The following firearms are allowed on this range:
Pistol Cartridge Lever Gun (PCLG), Centerfire Pistol,
Pistol Cartridge Carbine (PCC), 22 LR Rifle, 22 LR Pistol Only!

NO CENTERFIRE RIFLE CARTRIDGES OR SHOTGUNS ARE ALLOWED

(NO BOTTLE-NECK (Rifle Caliber) CARTRIDGE FIREARMS ALLOWED.)

- No casing or uncasing of firearms is allowed while the down range safety flag is displayed.
- Communication between shooters on the range is required prior to shooters going downrange to paint, tape or replace targets.
- When shooters are going down range “the down range safety flag must be deployed out in front of the firing line and withdrawn when the range is clear”.
- Stay behind the YELLOW LINE until shooters have returned from downrange.
- There will be no handling of firearms or associated equipment while shooters are down range.
- Firearms must be uncased and cased at the Shooting Line with muzzle pointing down range, and an empty chamber indicator (ECI) installed.
- When moving your firearm from one location to another an ECI (Empty Chamber Indicator) must be installed and the firearm must be carried in a vertical position with the muzzle up or in a case.
- Cross-firing from one side of the range to the other is not permitted. Shooters should align themselves with target array they wish to practice on.
- Shooters must stay behind the red firing line while shooting.
- Do not move targets from their current position on the Range.
- No steel targets are allowed inside the designated safe zone.
- Do Not Shoot at the Texas Star without the plates installed.
- NO SHOOTING OVER ANY BERM AT HILLSIDE TARGETS.
- Shooters are expected to police (pick up) their empty cartridge cases, brass, aluminum and steel, including rim-fire brass.
- It is the responsibility of all shooters to help keep the range clean and free of debris.
- To include all General Club Rules as posted.
