

Rifle Bay Range Rules

(There are no exceptions to these rules without prior permission of the Prescott Action Shooters Range Master)

- No casing or uncasing of firearms is allowed while the shooter down range safety flag is displayed.
- When shooters are going down range “the shooter down range safety flag must be deployed out in front of the firing line and withdrawn when the range is clear”.
- Communication between shooters on the range is required prior to shooters going down range to paint, tape or replace targets.
- There will be no handling of firearms or associated equipment while shooters are down range.
- Stay behind the YELLOW LINE until shooters have returned from downrange.
- Firearms must be uncased and cased at the Shooting Line with muzzle pointing down range, and an empty chamber indicator (ECI) installed.
- When moving your firearm from one location to another an ECI (Empty Chamber Indicator) must be installed and the firearm must be carried in a vertical position with the muzzle up.
- Cross-firing from one side of the range to the other is not permitted. Shooters should align themselves with target or targets they wish to practice on by moving to an appropriate bench.
- Shooters must stay behind the red firing line while shooting.
- All uncased firearms must have an ECI (Empty Chamber Indicator) installed when not in use at the firing line or in the rifle rack and while shooters are down range.
- Club members or their guests are NOT allowed on the hill.
- No personal targets are allowed on the hill other than those supplied by the range.
- No personal steel targets are allowed inside of 40 meters of the shooting line.
- Shooters are expected to police (pick up) their empty cartridge cases, brass, aluminum, rimfire and steel brass.
- It is the responsibility of all shooters to help keep the range clean and free of debris.
